Seniors are reminded of the importance of the Financial Aid process and applying for college. Seniors and their parent/guardian can apply for Financial Aid after January 1, 2010. You must complete and submit a Free Application for Federal Students Aid (FAFSA) to apply for federal student aid and to apply for most state and college aid. Applying online with FAFSA on the Web at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov) is faster and easier than using the paper FAFSA. Help is available in filling out the FAFSA at this website [www.studentaid.ed.gov/completestafsa](http://www.studentaid.ed.gov/completestafsa) or by calling 1-800-433-3243 to get help with any of your questions related to completing the FAFSA form. Please be aware of the deadlines for applying for the different aid programs and deadlines for colleges you want to receive your financial aid information.
